Day 1 Hanoi

Today you can check into your hotel and spend the day exploring the streets of Hanoi. Look for the Wide Eyed Tours welcome note at reception, on it your Tour Organiser will have arranged a time to meet you to run through the tour with you.

Day 2 Hanoi

This morning involves a half day bicycle tour (easy riding) followed by free time for you to explore Hanoi. Your suggestion sheets will give you some ideas on where to go & what to see.

Day 3 Halong Bay – overnight

After breakfast it's off to Ha Long Bay. On the boat you will eat an array of fresh sea food whilst cruising through some of the thousands of limestone karsts within this World Heritage site. There is an opportunity to swim in the bay's emerald waters, explore caves with incredible formations of stalactites and stalagmites and enjoy the tranquility of this bay of wonders. Settle in time, then dinner on board.

Day 4 Hanoi - Hue

An early rise this morning and for those who are keen, there is the opportunity to do some kayaking. After slowly making your way back to the port harbour, you begin your return journey back to Hanoi. In the evening you board the Reunification Express Train for the journey to Hue.

Day 5 Hue

After transferring to the hotel, brief settle in time then onto lunch trying local dishes such as Banh Khoai. After lunch you get to visit the Imperial Citadel, followed by one of Nguyen Emperors' tombs, the famed Thien Mu. Tonight you have the option to experience a traditional music performance whilst enjoying an eight course meal that was once reserved for royalty.

DAY 6 Hoi An

You will leave Hue and head south through coastal rice paddies to the fishing village of Lang Co, before taking the scenic mountainous route over the spectacular Hai Van Pass. In the afternoon, you will arrive at the once bustling river port of Hoi An (approx. 4 hours driving time). Declared a World Heritage site, the architecture of Hoi An is being beautifully restored and preserved. It's also a shopping mecca, with much to browse over and buy. Choose from original paintings, handcrafted woodwork, ceramics, embroidery, lanterns and more. Hoi An has also become famous for its tailoring - there is a huge variety of fabrics to choose from.

Day 7 Hoi An

Free day for you to make the most of what Hoi An has to offer. Enjoy the local sea food and relax on the beaches.

Day 8 Nha Trang

A morning flight has you arriving at Cam Ranh before taking a transfer to the beachside city of Nha Trang. After checking in there is time for swim or simply chill out & relax.

Day 9 Nha Trang

Swimming & sumptuous sea food is all that's on the agenda today

Day 10 Ho Chi Minh City

A short flight this morning from Cam Ranh to Ho Chi Minh. After transferring to the hotel, there is time to settle in, followed by a walking tour to some of Saigon's shopping spots. If shopping isn't your thing then maybe a relaxing drink at a roof top bar.

Day 11 Ho Chi Minh City – Cu Chi Tunnels

This morning is an early start to first go and visit the former Viet Cong stronghold at Cu Chi where the tunnel system provides a valuable insight into the tenacity and resourcefulness of the Vietnamese people. Back to HCM city, followed by free time. Some options include an orientation tour by cyclo of the main attractions, including the very sobering War Remnants Museum. Your hotel is centrally located to the city's main shopping district and Ben Thanh Market, so there is much for you to explore and discover during the afternoon.

Day 12

Departure day

Accommodation:

1-2 star hotels (9 nights), overnight on boat (1 night) overnight on train (1 night). Breakfast is included in all hotels where you have stayed the previous night.

Included Activities

Halong Bay group boat trip includes, guide meals & entrance fee; Hue private tour includes guide, transport, Imperial Citadel, Tomb in Hue, Private tour Cu Chi Tunnels includes transport, guide, entrance fees.

All flights/trains during the tour are included.
